
Grades I to V díd T - Shírt printing and painting of fruits and vegetables. Grades IV and V in addition wrote slogans and captions on T - Shirts.

At Gyanshree we believe that understanding to learn precedes learning to understand. Learning is an intensely sensory experience and has to go beyond the classroom. Shreeyans of grade XI were warmly welcomed to their new academic session through a week-long orientation program.

The objective of the orientation program was to familiarize and acclimatize the newly inducted Shreeyans to the ethos of the school and involve all Shreeyans in value-based interactive activities. The forty-hour program spread across six days, catered to the varied interests as well as diverse learning styles of the Shreeyans and was a meticulous combination of interactive workshops, motivational sessions, team building activities and field visits.

Shreeyans were ushered into their new classes and addressed by Ms. Rita Kapoor, Director/Manager, Ms. Brinda Ghosh, Principal and Ms. Sunita Mehta, Headmistress through the course of the week. The school was visited by luminaries like Mr. Subhashish Ghosh, Mr. Manav Gupta, Mr. Himanshu Ahluwalia and Mr. Pandey, who enthusiastically interacted with the students and seamlessly imparted techniques of goal-setting, thinking out of the box, and critical thinking and problem solving. The sessions had a harmonious blend of Science & technology, Arts & Culture, Values & Ethics and Community Outreach. Shreeyans underwent group meditation sessions through which they learnt to be mindful about themselves and the world around them.
